# Door-to-door separate waste collection system

From the 1st of October 2015 Mira has adopted a door-to-door separate waste collection system. Public garbage bins and all separate waste containers will gradually be removed and will be replaced by dedicated containers provided to each single household.



## COLLECTED MATERIALS

- ✓ Residual waste
- ✓ Organic waste
- ✓ Paper, cardboard, Tetra Pak cartons
- ✓ Plastic
- ✓ Glass, tins and metals
- ✓ Garden waste

## Out out containers.....

### When?

Waste containers can be left out for collection the night before the designated weekday stated in the "Eco calendar" (collection will begin in the morning).



### How?

Waste containers must be left outside the front doors of houses or businesses. Lids must be close and no bag should be hanging or left outside the containers.



Only the households that subscribed to the garden waste collection can leave it out by 12 am on the day of collection. Instructions on how to subscribe can be found on page 4.



**All materials and waste left outside the containers will not be collected.**

## which container should i use? how to separate waste correctly

### RESIDUAL WASTE



### Door-to-door collection once every two weeks

- leave the container out of the front door only if it is full and do not squash waste excessively
- do not leave materials on top or beside the container
- the container's lid must be closed



**NO**

- bulky items
- private construction materials and scraps
- paper, cardboard and Tetra Pak cartons
- glass, plastic and tins
- organic waste
- batteries, charged or exhausted
- medicines, even if expired
- electric and electronic waste

**YES**

- rubber
- soiled cloth
- receipts and carbon paper, plasticized, chemically treated or greased paper
- used pizza cartons
- plastic cutlery, clean or used, dirty plastic plates
- diapers and sanitary towels
- glass and crystal glasses
- vacuum cleaner bags
- small wooden and plastic objects broken toys (no electrics or electronics components)
- light bulbs (excluding neon lights) and ceramic fragments
- porcelain and earthenware
- marker pens, scissors and pens
- audio and video tapes, floppy disks, compact disks



## BASIC RULES OF SEPARATE WASTE COLLECTION

- ✓ receipts and carbon paper, plasticized, chemically treated or greased paper such as dirty pizza cartons must be disposed of in the residual waste container
- ✓ Tetra Pak (the material used for milk, wine, fruit juices, tomato sauce containers) must be rinsed and disposed of with paper
- ✓ Glasses, earthenware and ceramic (i.e. broken plates) must be disposed of in the residual waste
- ✓ Disposable plastic cups and plates, once rinsed, must be recycled as plastic, disposable plastic cutlery must be disposed of in the residual waste.

## PAPER, CARDBOARD AND TETRA PAK



### Door-to-door collection once every two weeks

- put each waste in the bin using no plastic bags
- do not dispose of greased/dirty paper
- do not leave materials on top or beside the container
- the container's lid must be closed



**NO**

- plasticised paper
- chemically treated or greased paper, receipts
- dirty pizza boxes

**YES**

- newspapers, magazines, comics, notebooks, books
- envelopes, photocopies, sheets of paper
- flyers and brochures
- Tetra Pak cartons for drinks and food (juices, milk, wine)
- cardboard containers and strips; cardboard
- cardboard boxes, including food ones; medicine boxes and instruction leaflets (not the medicine itself);
- cardboard egg boxes, clean cardboard pizza cartons.



**PLEASE NOTE:** *all material must be clean; otherwise it should go in the dry-waste bin.*

**PLASTIC BAGS MUST NOT BE USED TO DISPOSE OF PAPER, CARDBOARD AND TETRA PAK**

## GLASS, TINS AND METALS



### Door-to-door collection once every four weeks

- make sure you dispose of empty and clean glass, tin and metal containers
- do not leave materials on top or beside the container
- the container's lid must be closed



**NO**

- ceramic and porcelain
- glass and crystal drinking glasses
- Pyrex cookware
- other metallic objects (scissors, knives, screwdrivers)
- neon lights.

**YES**

- bottles
- tins and cans
- glass containers and dispensers
- empty glass jars
- tin foil and aluminum containers



**PLEASE NOTE:** *All material must be free of food or content residue*

## PLASTIC



### Door-to-door collection once every two weeks

- make sure you dispose of empty and clean plastic containers
- do not leave materials on top or beside the container
- the container's lid must be closed



**NO**

- plasticized paper
- chemically treated or greased
- paper, receipts
- dirty pizza boxes

**YES**

- bottles plastic containers and dispensers of detergents, soap, creams, shampoo and bubble bath;
- empty plastic toothpaste tubes containers and bags free of food residue
- cellophane and transparent plastic wrapper for food
- plastic containers and polystyrene for wrapping plastic bags or nets
- plastic buckets, dishes and bowls
- clean plastic cups and plates
- clean jerry cans and pots of washable paint
- bottle racks and crates.



**PLEASE NOTE:** *All material must be free of food or content residue*

## ORGANIC WASTE



### Door-to-door collection twice a week

- Do not leave materials on top or beside the container
- The container's lid must be closed



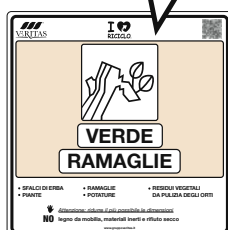
**NO**

- diapers and sanitary towels
- rags and cloths
- packaging and containers
- non non-biodegradable coffee capsules

**YES**

- Kitchen waste, food left-overs
- fruit and vegetable, stale bread
- used coffee and teabags
- rotting and expired food, egg shells
- cut flowers and domestic plants
- dirty paper napkins
- small domestic animal litter.

## GARDEN WASTE



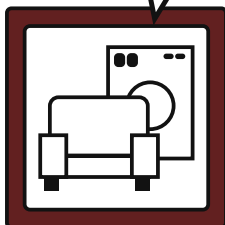
Grass, leaves, twigs, plants, small logs can be brought to Recycling centre (Ecocentro) in Mirano or delivered by door to door weekly appointment.

Collection

**once a week from March to November**  
**once a month from December to February**

- Garden waste collection requires the subscription of the service through Dolo customer service. For information you can also contact the "Eco sportello" located by Mira municipality offices.
- Door-to-door collection can be requested by calling the toll free number 800.011249 two days before the collection date stated in the calendar. During the call please follow the instructions provided and dial the reference number that can also be found in the TARI bill.

## BULKY ITEMS



**There are three different ways of disposing of bulky and hazardous waste:**

1. Recycling centre (Ecocentro). Small and bigger size household goods (e.g. computers, printers, food processors, television sets, sound systems, domestic appliances, furniture), vegetable and mineral oils, metals and electronic equipment of household use must be brought to the recycling centre in Mirano, Viale Venezia 3, from Monday to Saturday opening hours 7.30-10am and 2-6 pm.

2. Bulky items door to door collection upon reservation. Bulky items can be collected from households for free up to a cubic metre. Reservations on: <http://www.gruppoveritas.it/prenota-il-tuo-servizio/asporto-rifiuti-ingombranti>

3. Eco mobile. Private households can also dispose of bulky items, household and electronic appliances, wood, iron, and hazardous items (batteries, car batteries, vegetable and mineral oils, ink, toners and mercury appliances) through the Eco mobile.

Piazza mercato, from 8 to 12.30 am;  
**ORIAGO VIA SABBIONA** - 3rd Friday of each month  
Stadium, from 7.30 to 11.30 am  
**BORBIAGO** - 2nd Friday of each month  
Via Botte, from 7.30 to 11.30 am

## ECO MOBILE – OIL COLLECTION

**YES**

Vegetable oil from domestic use both fried (filtered) and from tins and cans; mineral oil, car brakes oil, domestic production antifreeze liquid. USED MOTOR OIL can also be brought to any car dealer which has the duty to collect it for free.

**NO**

vegetable oils from non domestic use (e.g. restaurants, etc.) mineral oils from businesses (e.g. car repair shops, garages, etc)
